## Keynote Speaker - Colin Maclachlan

Colin Maclachlan is a former SAS soldier with over 25 years of security and risk related experience. Colin has also appeared in Channel 4's SAS: Who Dares Wins and Channel 5's Secrets of the SAS.


Colin joined the army in 1989 and following 9 years in the Royal Scots he passed SAS selection first time. He was fortunate enough to have been involved in some of the SAS' more high profile and daring missions of the recent period.

Only a handful of men have been involved in hostage negotiations, hostage rescue and been a hostage themselves and Colin is one of them. He waded through swamps in Sierra Leone to hunt down the 'West Side Boys', a guerrilla gang holding 11 British soldier's hostage. It was a mission so dangerous they nicknamed it Operation Certain Death – it's real name was Operation Barras.

Only a handful of men have been involved in hostage negotiations, hostage rescue and been a hostage themselves and Colin is one of them.
